The way of application: The submission of required documents in English or Spanish to Mrs. Kateřina Dolnák

Date of submission: **till 18th May 12:00**

What to submit:

- Application
- CV
- Letter of motivation (1 × A4)
- Project's abstract (max. 500 words) (see next page for topics)

1st round of competition: **18th-19th May 2017**

2nd round of competition: **26th May 2017**

Internship dates:

Serbia: September/October 2017
Ghana: September 2017
Nicaragua: October/November 2017

Length of stay: **1 month**

Information about competition:

The first round of the competition will consist of an interview in English or Spanish, depending on the destination (so called screening). Based on the screening, the applicants who will proceed to the next round will be chosen.

Based on the second round, the applicants who will get the internship with the supervision of FRRMS employees will be chosen.

Financial conditions:

Faculty will arrange and pay for successful students (5 students for each target destination):

- a) return ticket – the economy class flight ticket or bus/train ticket to Serbia
- b) comprehensive travel insurance, up to max. amount of CZK 90 / day
- c) transportation to the airport and back, up to max. amount of CZK 700,
- d) organized local transport in the country of destination,
- e) accommodation in the location, up to max. amount of CZK 1100 / night
- f) internship program.

Proposed framework topics based on collaboration with local stakeholders

Nicaragua

- Living conditions of rural communities on municipalities Diriamba, Dolores and Jinotepe and their improvement
- Ecosystem services in Carazo region and their benefits for local people
- Elimination of impacts of landfill in Diriamba on environment
- Evaluation of landscape potential for regional development in Carazo region
- Education of local people on waste management and sorting
- Water quality in streams near on municipalities Diriamba, Dolores and Jinotepe area
- Gender relations in Nicaraguan culture
- Development of sustainable tourism in Carazo region
- Perception of the USA and historical memory of the revolution

Ghana

- Ecosystem services of National Park KAKUM
- Waste management in Accra
- Availability of drinking water in cities
- Impacts of Illegal mining on agriculture
- Food security
- Value adding to fruit (pineapple, mango, orange etc.)

Serbia
