

English Language Requirement

All applicants are required to submit proof of English language proficiency. The University accepts **only** the following English language certificates:

Accepted Certificates

Cambridge English Qualifications

- B2 First (FCE): minimum **160 points** on the Cambridge English Scale
- or a higher-level Cambridge English qualification

IELTS Academic

- Overall score: **minimum 5.5**

TOEFL iBT

- Total score: **minimum 72**

Duolingo English Test

- Total score: **minimum 100**

Certificate Validity

The certificate must not be older than two (2) years on the date the application is submitted.

Certificates older than two years will not be accepted. No exceptions will be granted.

How to Submit the Certificate

Applicants must submit:

- a clear colour scan / copy of the original certificate or official score report;
- the complete document, including all pages;
- all QR codes, Certificate IDs, Test Report Form (TRF) numbers, registration numbers, candidate numbers, verification codes, or any other identifiers used to verify the authenticity of the result must be fully visible and readable.

Scans with missing, cropped, blurred, hidden, or unreadable verification information may be rejected.

The English language certificate must be submitted together with:

- the documents required for the verification of previous education, or
- a copy of the nostrification certificate, where applicable.

Certificates submitted separately may not be processed.

Personal Details

The applicant's **full name and date of birth on the English language certificate must exactly match the full name and date of birth shown in the applicant's passport or other official identity document submitted with the application.**

If there is any discrepancy in personal data, the University may request additional supporting documents or may reject the certificate.

Important Notice

Only the four certificate types listed above are accepted.

The University does not accept any other English language certificates, examinations, tests, statements, language school certificates, institutional confirmations, employer letters, medium-of-instruction letters, or any other alternative proof of English proficiency.

Please do not contact the University to request approval of another certificate or test. Such requests will not be considered. No exceptions are made to this requirement.

Applicants who submit a certificate other than one of the four accepted certificates listed above will not fulfill the English language requirement.

Before submitting your application, please ensure that:

1. your certificate is one of the accepted types listed above;
2. you have achieved the required minimum score;
3. the certificate is not older than two years;
4. the verification code, QR code, Certificate ID, or any other authentication identifier is clearly visible;
5. the name and date of birth on the certificate exactly match those in your passport;
6. the certificate is submitted together with your educational documents or nostrification documents.

Failure to meet any of the above requirements may result in the English language certificate not being accepted for admission purposes.
